Computer software Category:Multimedia software Suur Puu Suur Puu was a project that used explosive decompression and thermal gradients to create a large chamber. The project's goal was to demonstrate a practical method for landing on the Moon. Operation Suur Puu's objective was to produce a chamber in the shape of a sphere about 100 meters across. The chamber would be created by using a suitcase sized explosive shell. The shell was dropped down a funnel, and the ignition of the shell and its subsequent acoustic wave would compress air surrounding the shell. The resulting shockwave would compress the air, thereby compressing air and forcing it into the sphere's throat. Pressurized air would then be used to descend to the bottom of the "crater" (actually a tube). The projectile descent was caused by two mechanisms. First, the pressure inside the funnel, which was ultimately the only pressure able to leave the chamber, steadily decreased as the shell dropped. This pressure gradient worked with a siphon to draw air into the chamber. Once the shell reached a pressure of about 2.5 bars it was blown. The shockwave from the blast allowed air to flow out of the chamber, and thus out of the funnel and into the bottom of the "crater". Suur Puu proved that it was theoretically possible to create a large chamber, capable of holding of air. The chamber was not used for a successful Moon landing, but rather as part of a demonstration of how to land on the Moon, as part of the aborted US-Soviet Union joint lunar program.
